## Assembly Instructions for Large Mausoleums

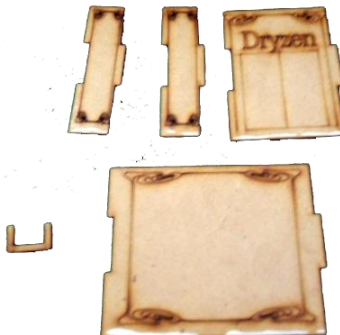
### Required Materials

- Large Mausoleum Kit from Angry Mojo Games
- Glue, we recommend wood glue
- Rubbing alcohol
- Rag or paper towel

The large mausoleums from our Graveyard big box are easy and fast to assemble. First you want to locate the following pieces.



1. Thoroughly clean all the pieces, especially the edges, with rubbing alcohol and a rag. This is important, during the manufacturing process the laser will burn and melt the resin holding the fiberboard together and this leaves quite a bit of soot and residue. If that soot is present, glue will have a difficult time holding the piece together.
2. Separate these pieces, the front section with the name on it, the two front pillar sections with the detail work, the back with the extended bottom, and the u-shaped nubbin. The bottoms of these pieces are extended 1/8 of an inch, run a line of glue along the bottom.

3. Place the wall pieces into the appropriate notches on the floor. All the detail work should be visible over the floor section.



4. Glue the u-shaped nubbin in place as shown. This will form the support for the stairs later on.

5. Run lines of glue along the remaining wall and column pieces wherever they will be meeting another place. I glue along the horizontal edge where the slot is, as well as along the vertical surface where the tab is.



6. Place the remaining wall sections along the extended wall sections. This should wrap around the shape of the mausoleum.



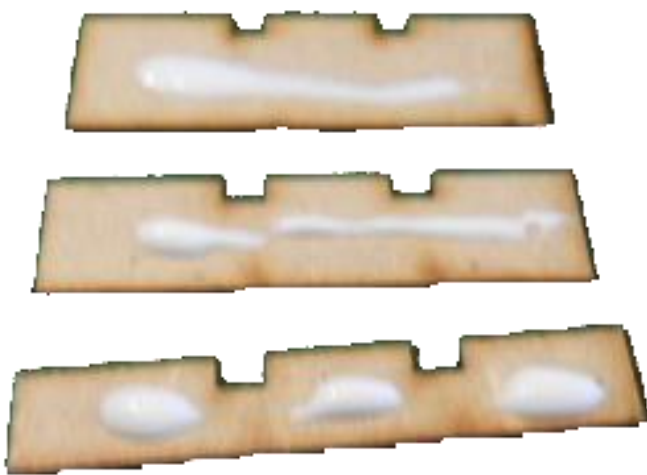

7. Glue the bottoms of the stair pieces. Make sure to dry fit these in place first, as they are asymmetrical.



8. Glue the stairs in place using the u-shaped nubbin as a guide and support. Place the largest one down first, with the smallest wrapping it up.

9. Glue the ceiling guide rails on the underside of the roof piece. Dry fit first, they only go one way, but the two are interchangeable.



10. Place the roof on top of the mausoleum, the project is now complete. With the ceiling rails in place, the roof is removable.
